

SANDOWN TOWN MAP



The Isle of Wight Community Rail Partnership (CRP) has worked with Sandown Business Association, Sandown Community Partnership, Sandown Town Council, and the Isle of Wight Council on initiatives to improve signage to the town and to look at ways of improving the environment around the station whilst involving the community and young people.

Children from Sandown Church of England Primary School were invited to enter an art competition entitled 'Sandown, my town' from which 10 winning designs have been replicated onto glass blocks, (produced by Glory Art Glass in Melville Street) and placed in the pavement as a 'Rail Trail'. This trail will take you on the most direct route into the town, both highlighted on this map and in the DL Leaflet. The publication also shows the original drawings from the children and is available on the trains, and from shops and organisations in the town.

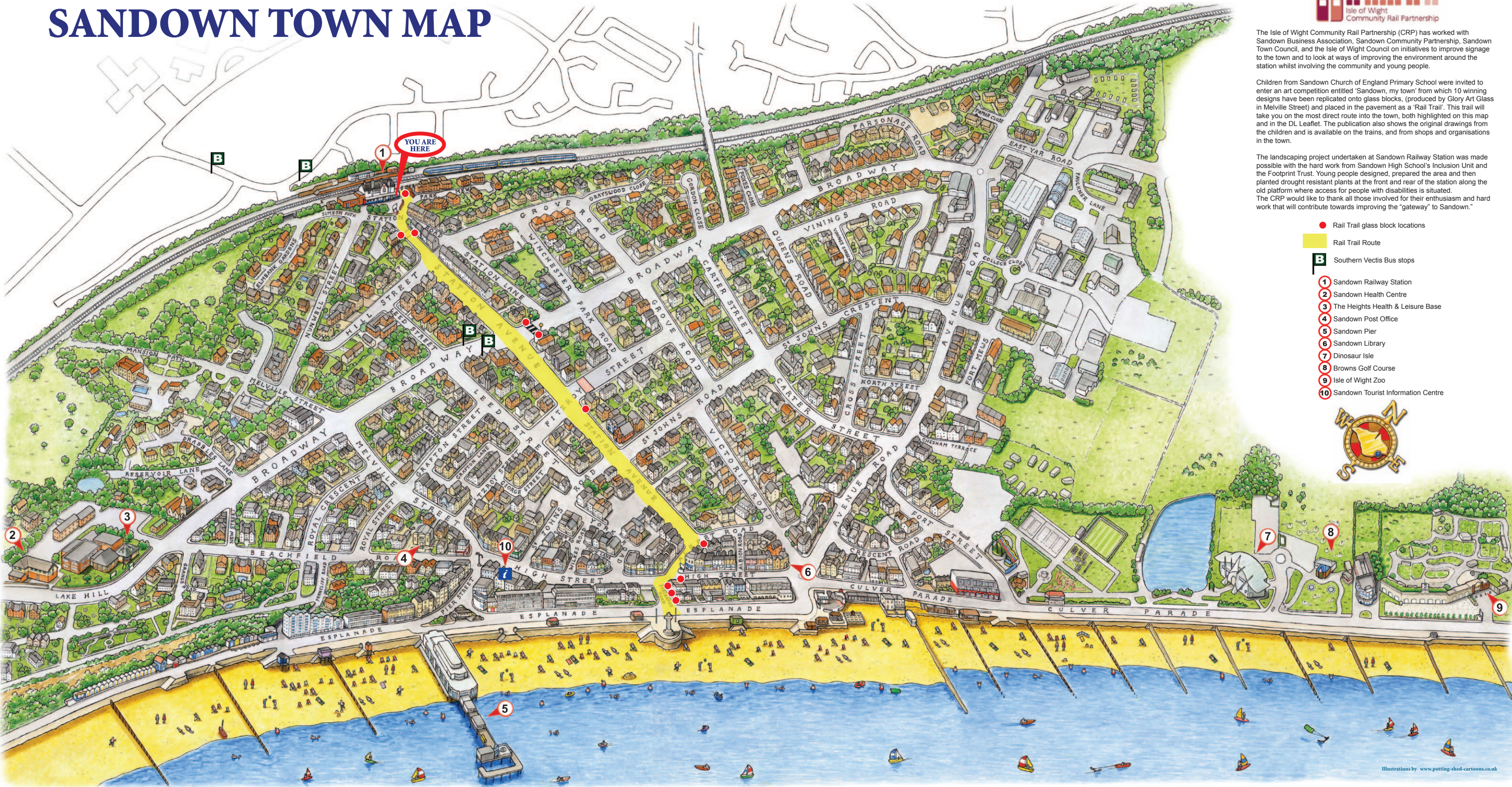
The landscaping project undertaken at Sandown Railway Station was made possible with the hard work from Sandown High School's Inclusion Unit and the Footprint Trust. Young people designed, prepared the area and then planted drought resistant plants at the front and rear of the station along the old platform where access for people with disabilities is situated. 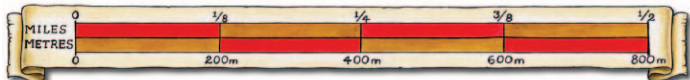
